Food Law compliance

Based on written confirmations from our suppliers we herewith can declare that the used internal lacquers for our beer and beverage cans and ends do meet:

- The Requirements according to Art. 3 Regulation EC No. 1935/2004.
- The European Directive 2004/16/EC on "Epoxy Derivatives in materials intended to come into contact with Food. And subsequent amendment 2004/13/EC.
- The requirements of § 31 (1) of the German Food and Material Law.
- The requirements specified in the US-FDA Regulation 21 CFR 175.300.

This means that the formulations of these lacquers are according to the relevant positive lists and that the appropriate global and specific migration limits are fulfilled.

We have available certificates from independent laboratories which underlined the statements from our suppliers.

The used external lacquers and inks are formulated according to

- The CEPE-General Exclusion List of Substances for Printing Inks and Coatings
- The sum of concentrations of lead, cadmium, mercury and chromium VI are below the level of < 100 ppm as required by the European Commission Directive 94/62/EC Art. 11 on Packaging and Packaging Waste.
